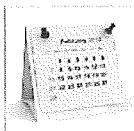
## CROSSFIRE SCAVENGER HUNT

# Denny & Sue Dyvig

Missionaries to Nairobi, Kenya

Dear Friends at Oak Hill,

“Dad, Sam just passed away two hours ago.” Those are some of the hardest words I have heard in my life. It was our first daughter, Mary, who had just called us from the USA. Mary and Sam were married three and a half years ago. They have one daughter, Menna, two and a half, and a baby on the way, due about September 1<sup>st</sup>. You may remember that Mary grew up in the other major world religion. When she came to know Christ her life was in danger and she miraculously escaped to Kenya where she lived with us until she could go to the USA as a religious asylum seeker. When she got married, we were happy that Mary would finally begin a new life, and she did. But we didn’t know that phase of her life would be so short-lived.

About a year ago, with the help of her husband and friends, Mary founded a Christian organization called Manna Grace. Her goal is to teach American Christians about the religion she grew up in, and to encourage all believers to do evangelism among these often unreached and neglected people. Manna Grace is also supporting evangelistic and discipleship ministries in eastern and NE Africa. Mary has helped Sue and me and we love serving with her.

Mary and her husband never had much money, but they had a good life together. Mary’s passion is to keep the Manna Grace ministry going and growing. Mary has a burden for evangelism that is equaled by few I have met in my life. We love that about her! We know God has a good plan for our Mary. We do ask you to pray with us for Mary, Menna, and unborn baby Sam. Please pray that God will lovingly steer her through these difficult times, and give her continuing hope and peace and joy. Please pray that God will cause Manna Grace to continue to serve and grow, that many will know Jesus Christ and be strong in Him! Though Mary was not born to us in the “normal” physical way, we believe she is our true daughter anyway. I don’t know how we could ever love her more, or be more proud of any child who might have been born to us. Mary’s loss hurts Sue and me deeply. Will you please pray for Sue and me as we seek to be a channel of love from our great God to our wonderful daughter, Mary.

Thanks for your support for Sue and me. We did not become missionaries to be blessed, but we have been blessed, richly. One of the greatest blessings God has given us is our daughter Mary and her daughter Menna (with the new baby soon to arrive)! Please thank God with us for Mary, Sam (with Jesus in heaven), Menna, and soon-to-be-born baby Sam Adam. We thank God for all of you there at Oak Hill and for your generous financial support, prayers, and encouragement!
